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## How We May Use and Share Your Information

We may use or share your health information for purposes related to:

- Treatment: Providing dental hygiene care and services.
- Payment: Billing insurance, grant reporting, or sliding-scale documentation when applicable.
- Healthcare Operations: Quality improvement, record-keeping, and administrative activities necessary to run our nonprofit services.

We may also share information when required by law, such as for public health reporting or compliance with legal processes.

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## Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Request a copy of your health records.
  - Ask us to correct information you believe is inaccurate or incomplete.
  - Request limits on how your information is used or shared.
  - Request confidential communication methods.
  - Receive a paper or electronic copy of this Notice at any time.

Aurora Dental Hygiene does not sell or use your health information for marketing purposes. Access to your information is limited to authorized personnel only and is stored securely.
